


JSS Vidyagiri Campus, Dharwad

B.B.A. (Bachelor of Business Administration)

The Government of Karnataka and the Karnatak University, Dharwad have permitted the Janata Shikshana Samiti's Banashankari Arts, Commerce and Shantikumar Gubbi Science College to start the Bachelor of Business Administration Course. Realising the importance of the course in the present context, the Management of JSS has decided to launch the same from the academic year 1996/97 itself. The college has necessary infrastructure like adequate building, qualified staff and computer facilities required for the course.

Education in Business Management Science opens varied avenues for employment in Industry, Banking, Agriculture, Transportation, Communication and other nation building activities. Our economic progress depends on the efficiency and competence of managerial services in public undertaking, private concerns, joint sector ventures of co-operatives. The phenomenal growth of small industries in urban and rural areas throughout the country demands a large body of competent Managers with comprehensive knowledge of the many functions of Management. But for all that challenge of the coming year is exciting, dynamic and full of opportunities.

- 1. Students of B.B.A. are exposed to functional knowledge of Personal Management, Financial Management, Office Management, Industrial Management, Production Management, Computer Language, C & C++ Programming, Data Based Management, System and Software in Business Application, Costing, Financial Accounting, E-commerce, Marketing Research, Business Taxation and Service Marketing.
- 2. They gain necessary knowledge and skills of Business Management required for self employment and to establish own business.
- 3. They are eligible for higher studies like MBA, MCA, M.Com., ICWA, CA, ACSC, LL.B., after graduation.

4. B.B.A Graduates have job opportunities in the managerial & executives sector like Junior Executive Managerial Assistants, Management Trainees, Officers, Personal Assistants, etc. in Banks, Industrial / Commercial Houses, Private / Public / Government organisations.

Eligibility for Admission

- I) A pass in Two Year Pre-University examination in Arts / Commerce / Science or an equivalent examination approved by the Karnatak University.
- II) Candidates securing less than 45 Marks need not apply(For SC/ST 40 marks).
- III) The selection of the candidates for admission to the College will be made on the basis of merit and final selection is based upon interview or marks of previous exam

Admission

1. The selected candidates who have paid the requisite fee are deemed to have admitted to the college.



Aims and Objectives

- 6. To produce persons trained with etiquette, intellect, physical, moral, spiritual and the like.
- 7. To make the students to strive after excellence in learning initiative and co-operative leadership and to develop a practical awareness of the prevailing social conditions and commitment

- 2. All admissions to this College, will however deemed to be provisional, until they are approved by the Karnatak University. Those who migrate to from other University / Boards should produce an eligibility certificate to First B.B.A. The eligibility fee will have to be paid by the candidate as prescribed by the University.
- 3. Admissions are made on the clear understanding that those who are admitted will fully accept the rules and regulations in force in the college which may be framed from time to time irrespective of the fact that the University regulations do not contain such rules or these rules are not in force in other similar institutions. Every student admitted to the college is bound by the College regulations, as set forth in the College calender or as may be modified from time to time.
- 4. Principal may refuse admission to any student without giving any reason.
- 5. A candidate may be asked to withdraw from the course at any time during/at the end of the first semester if in the opinion of the principal the candidate is not likely to benefit from the course and such decision shall be final.

How to Apply for Admission

- I) The application in the prescribed form should be filled completely in by the candidate's own hand writing and should reach the principal within 10 days from the date of announcement of II P.U.C. results which ever is earlier with the following:

Selection Procedure

- 1. The selection of candidates for admission to the BBA will be made on the basis of merit.
- 2. The final Selection is based upon written test/viva voce. The written test / entrance exam is aimed at measuring general aptitude and awareness of the candidate. The test is for 100 marks with one hour duration. (No single text book or guide will help you to prepare for the written test since the test is not based on any specific course of study/programme). It requires a constant touch with newspapers, magazines, General knowledge books etc. Model question paper of the written test is enclosed with the prospectus.

- 3. Candidates called for interview should be accompanied by the parents or who are to finance their studies at college.
- 4. At the time of interview, the candidates should submit the following certificates.
- a) Conduct certificate (Original)
- b) Transfer certificate (Original / Application for T.C.)
- c) Secondary School Leaving Certificate (Xerox Copy)
- d) Pre University Examination Marks Card (Original & Xerox Copy)
- e) Caste certificate if any, in original. (For Karnataka students only)
- f) Four copies of passport size photos.
- g) Eligibility certificate, if the candidates are coming from any other University / Boards etc.
- h) 4 Self Addressed Envelops. (with Rs. 5/-Stamp Affixed)

Schedule of Fees

The College admission fees will be collected at the beginning of the semester along with extra fee for maintenance.

Fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstance.

Exams, Semester and other Details

- I) The programme is designed to make it employment oriented and more or less a terminal course. The whole course will serve the purpose only when instructions are given to make the study oriented or tilting it towards vocationalisation.
- ii) B.B.A. is a 3 years course with 6 semester and at the end of each semester there will be an examination conducted by the University. Each semester will be of about 16 weeks duration followed by examination and a brief term work break.
- iii) Each course will be examined out of 100 marks of which 25 marks will be assigned for class tests, attendance, assignment project report etc., which will be examined by the course teacher. The term and examination will thus be out of 75 marks.
- iv) There will not be any pass class. Those scoring 50 percent or more and less than 60 percent in the aggregate for all the semester will be declared to have

Inplant training Project and Viva

- 1. Each student is required to undergo two separate 30 days inplant training (III and V Semester). One teacher of the concered college will act as internal guide for the inplant training.
- 2. At the end of the first inplant training a student is required to submit his report to the Principal before the commencement of the Fourth Semester Examination.
- 3. At the end of the second inplant training a student is required to submit his report to the University before the commencement of the Sixth Semester examination.
- 4. There will be a common evaluation of both the inplant report. The reports will be evaluated out of 50 Marks and the viva will be for 50 marks.
